1. CALL TO ORDER:

At 9 a.m., Board Chairwoman Stacey Mitchell called the meeting to order.

The Houston Forensic Science Center, Inc. ("HFSC" and/or the "corporation") board of directors (the "board") convened this in-person meeting on Friday, December 10, 2021 in the City Hall Council Annex Chamber, 900 Bagby St. (public level), Houston, Texas 77002. In a manner permitted by the corporation's bylaws, the meeting was called by providing all directors with notice of the date, time and purpose of the meeting at least three days before the scheduled date.

In accordance with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code (Texas Open Meetings Act) a notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board located on the exterior wall of the City Hall building at 901 Bagby on December 7.

Chairwoman Mitchell declared a quorum was present noting that all members were physically present.

3. **PUBLIC COMMENT**:

Chairwoman Mitchell gave members of the public an opportunity to address the board. No members of the public addressed the board.

4. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PRIOR MEETING:

Following a motion by Director Lois Moore and seconded by Director Ellen Cohen, the board unanimously approved the November 12, 2021 meeting minutes.

5. CHAIRWOMAN MITCHELL'S REPORT

The chairwoman noted that the event planning committee planned several fun activities for staff, including the annual holiday party on December 18 at Revelry on Richmond. She encouraged all members to attend. The corporation does not use taxpayers' dollars for such events, and so the chairwoman requested board members make monetary donations to help pay for the party.

Next, she announced HFSC recently launched a new website that utilizes a shorter domain name, www.hfsctx.gov. Some of the website updates on the homepage make it more user-friendly and for the first time in HFSC's history, all board members' pictures will be on the website.

She reminded members to review the detailed data from the previous month and take note of the challenges HFSC is facing on several fronts.

6. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF BOARD RESOLUTION 2021-001 SETTING MEETINGS:

Pursuant to the corporation's bylaws, the board considered a resolution to change its schedule of regular meetings from monthly to every other month. Chairwoman Mitchell reminded the board that the resolution still allows them to call special and emergency meetings as needed. She then opened the floor for further discussion or questions. The board discussed the reasoning behind the proposed new schedule and Chairwoman Mitchell stated the change would reduce redundancy in staff reports allowing them to see trends over longer periods of time. She also acknowledged that HFSC's well-established infrastructure and leadership make the monthly board meetings less necessary. Lastly, Chairwoman Mitchell noted that if the board subsequently decided the new schedule was ineffective, the board could decide to revert back to monthly meetings.

Director Moore made a motion to approve board resolution 2021-001, to schedule the regular meeting of the board every other month, starting in January 2022. Director Francisco Medina seconded the motion, and the board unanimously approve board resolution 2021-001.

7. CLOSED MEETING/EXECUTIVE SESSION

The board convened in a closed meeting, also referred to as executive session. The executive session was held in accordance with Texas Government Code Sections 551.071 and 551.074(a), for the purpose of consulting with the corporation's attorney and discussing Dr. Peter Stout, president and CEO's employment agreement.

Chairwoman Mitchell closed the open meeting at 9:11 a.m. and convened the executive session.

8. RECONVENE INTO OPEN MEETING:

At 9:24 a.m., Chairwoman Mitchell reconvened the open meeting. She announced a quorum was present.

9. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A FIVE-YEAR EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT FOR DR. PETER STOUT:

The chairwoman first reminded members that they discussed extending or renewing Dr. Stout's agreement in July and authorized her and her designees to act on behalf of the board to negotiate a new agreement. She announced the corporation and Dr. Stout had reached a final agreement and requested the members consider those changes as presented. She added that the new contract would go into effect Jan. 13, 2022, and end January 2027. She noted Dr. Stout's salary would remain the same though his purchasing authority would increase from \$200,000 to \$300,000 to reflect the cost of several technologies and equipment that HFSC routinely purchases. Pursuant to the agreement, the chairwoman will receive notice from Dr. Stout regarding purchases over \$200,000. She stated the board will update relevant HFSC's policies and board resolutions to reflect this change and resolve those items at a later board meeting.

Director Philip Hilder then made a motion to approve a five-year employment agreement between HFSC and Dr. Stout to continue serving as president and CEO, and Director Moore seconded the motion. The board unanimously approved the motion.

10. <u>CONSIDER AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH MATTERPORT FOR 3D</u> TECHNOLOGY:

Dr. Stout began by sharing that HFSC continues to look for ways to make crime scene analysts' work less manual, more complete and faster since they spend a lot of time documenting and measuring scenes. He asked the board to approve a contract with Matterport for a product that would allow crime scene investigators (CSIs) to map scenes more efficiently and provide stakeholders a better final product. The technology would be used in conjunction with drones, which allow for exterior mapping but are nearly impossible to use in an indoor setting. The Matterport technology employs a scanning device and allows a CSI to scan the scene in approximately 30 seconds and provide a 3D image with measurements to stakeholders. The individual scanners cost about \$2,500 and Dr. Stout plans to purchase one for each shift. The instruments require validation to ensure they operate as expected, and to show the accuracy of the measurements, as well as the instruments' limitations. Dr. Stout said the Matterport technology should be validated and ready to use by fall 2022. Because the final details of the agreement are still in negotiation, Dr. Stout asked the board to delegate authority to him to complete negotiations and sign the final agreement.

Director Cohen made a motion to delegate authority to Dr. Stout to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Matterport for a total contract value of \$260,000. Director Hilder seconded the motion, and the board unanimously approved the motion.

11. ADJOURNMENT:

Chairwoman Mitchell requested a motion to adjourn the meeting. Director Moore made a motion to adjourn. Director Medina seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 9:44 a.m.

RESOLUTION REGARDING AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW FUNDS OF THE CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Houston Forensic Science Center, Inc. (the "Corporation" or "HFSC") has concluded the Corporation's interests will be served by revising procedures for disbursement from the Corporation's funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board has concluded that it is in the best interests of the Corporation to increase the amount of disbursement within the authority of the President and CEO, and that such action will further the purposes of the Corporation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DIRECTORS OF CORPORATION:

SECTION 1. That the findings contained in the preamble of this Resolution are declared to be true and correct and are adopted as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of this Resolution the following terms have the meanings stated:

- (a) "Account Signer" means a person whose Signature authorizes a disbursement from the Corporation's funds in a manner consistent with (i) this Resolution; (ii) the Corporation's agreements with the bank into which the Corporation deposits its funds; and (iii) applicable law.
- (b) "CEO" means the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation.
- (c) "CFO" means the Chief Financial Officer of the Corporation.
- (d) "Chair" means the Chair of the Corporation's Board of Directors.
- (e) "COO" means the Chief Operating Officer of the Corporation.
- (f) "Signature" includes "electronic signature" as defined by Section 322.002(8), Texas Business & Commerce Code.
- (g) "Vice Chair" means the Vice Chair of the Corporation's Board of Directors.

SECTION 3. That the following persons are Account Signers, but only for disbursements in the amounts listed below:

Any one of the CEO, CFO, or COO.

\$20,000.00 or more but less than \$100,000.00.

Any two of the CEO, CFO, or COO.

The CEO and either the CFO or COO.

The CEO, and either the CFO or COO, along with either the Chair or Vice Chair.

SECTION 4. That to the extent any provisions of Resolution 2012-003, 2013-001, 2013-002, or 2015-001 are inconsistent with this Resolution, the said provisions of the previous Resolutions are repealed.

RETIRE CAPITAL EQUIPMENT LEASES

HFSC leased capital equipment for \$1.4 million in FY22

- Mostly to distribute cost impact
- Highly specialized equipment located in the toxicology and forensic/DNA sections
 - Rapid DNA instrument and 3 LC-QQQ instruments

Retiring the leases is cost-effective

- Frees \$300,000/year for the next 3 to 5 years to redirect toward personnel costs
- Personnel critical to address the rising case load and impacts across HFSC
- Purchases the DNA and toxicology equipment outright

TOXICOLOGY OUTSOURCE - \$400,000 FY22 AND \$300,000 FY23

- The number of cases received for analysis in FY2020 up 46% and FY2021 up 24%. Complexity up 40%
- Rebuilding methods delayed due to COVID (staffing and accreditation)
- One of two disciplines that can be outsourced
- COVID 2020 reversed progress on DUID backlog, without outsourcing backlog (orange bars) will only increase
- Approximately 1,500 cases backlogged
- Plan to outsource 50 cases weekly
- Courts impatient



OVERTIME COSTS -- \$300,000 FY22


- Overtime primarily in CSU increased 40%






Sentencing phase of a trial


- Prior convictions become relevant during sentencing
 - Prosecutors may increase sentencing range and argue for more severe punishment
- Must prove convictions belong to the defendant (beyond a reasonable doubt)
 - Cannot prove by simply using defendant's name
 - Typically proven by comparing prints on past sentencing records to the defendant




Jail cards and pen packs

Predominant practice in Harris County

- Historically, Harris County Sheriff's Office performed this work
- HFSC has never provided this service, even under HPD
- Examiners are called to court at sentencing to roll prints and compare with pen pack or judgement and sentence
- Work is usually done in court, as soon as a guilty verdict is reached
- However, evaluation of judgement and sentence/pen pack may be done prior to sentencing hearing



Reasons for how we ended up here today

- Enormous court backlog due to pandemic and lasting impact of hurricane Harvey, places a huge demand on HCCSO
- HCSO recently decided to push J&S work to the law enforcement agency who investigated the case on trial
- HPD makes up roughly ¾ of the cases filed in Harris County courts



Challenges for HFSC

- ISO 17025:2017 guidelines have multiple points where the exam-on-the-stand is incompatible
 - No review
 - No documentation
 - No report
 - Verbal release of results
- ANAB response: work COULD be characterized as field testing
 - Individual laboratory can assess the risk, draft appropriate SOP
- TFSC: latent prints is statutorily exempted from TFSC oversight
 - But code of professional conduct does apply to HFSC as a whole

Here and now: the impacts of J&S

- Many conversations with HCSO, HCDAO and HPD
- CURRENT HFSC workflow:
 - Require a subpoena
 - Require pen pack to the lab 2 weeks in advance
 - Require prints be rolled several days before testimony, so comparisons meet all qualitybased requirements
 - Majority of cases worked will not go to sentencing
 - Received over **212** subpoenas in less than 3 months to complete this work
 - Misdemeanor cases have not yet been included on a regular basis
- Serious impact to capacity and is effectively unmanageable
 - Examiners taken off HPD case work
 - Reduced ability to provide testimony on cases
 - Section backlog reduction estimates have already been reduced close to 70%

What we have tried and the path moving forward

- Offered to HCSO to take any amount of case work and give them capacity to handle increase in J&S work – declined
- Topic is on the TFSC agenda for meeting next Friday to discuss the accreditation implications
- No clear path forward for HFSC that aligns with accreditation, best practice and maintaining section productivity

















Key for Dashboard Section Pages

Ring=breakdown of age for all pending cases





Subject:	Consider approval of a contract with Signature Science, LLC (Signature Science) to provide DNA services for HFSC forensic biology cases, and designate authority to Dr. Stout to finalize said contract for signature.
Background:	HFSC was awarded the FY 2021- BJA DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction federal grant to help address HFSC's current backlog of forensic biology cases. HFSC has consistently utilized outsourcing in the forensic biology section to assist with various operational needs over the years. This grant will specifically assist HFSC in working through its backlog of sexual assault kits, which is a priority for the Corporation and its stakeholders. Without the use of federal funds, HFSC would not be able to complete this important project at this time.
Executive Summary:	In March 2021, HFSC issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for DNA outsourcing services to be funded by the BJA DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction federal grant. After consideration of the stated selection criteria, Signature Science was selected as the successful respondent. The proposed contract anticipates the total project budget for Signature Science's services will not exceed the total grant budget for outsourcing, \$451,365.00. HFSC will be responsible for ensuring the total expenditure for services provided, does not exceed the total grant budget. While HFSC has been awarded the grant for this fiscal year, funds are still pending release from BJA and the final contract cannot yet be executed. Thus, authority to complete negotiations and finalize the contract, must be delegated to Dr. Stout to begin outsourcing as soon as funds are released. Also of note, during the April 9, 2021 regular Board meeting, the members reached a consensus regarding utilizing existing Corporate procurement policies to approve budget adjustments and increases, for grant funded projects. Pursuant to the board resolutions governing approval thresholds for corporate expenditures, once the Board approves a grant funded contract, the Board Chair may authorize subsequent budget adjustments in conjunction with the appropriate corporate officers, and execute any necessary contract amendments.

HFSC Mid-Year Fiscal 2022 Review


HFSC - Fiscal Year 2021 Review




FY 2022 YTD Spending by Category


